The Fair offers a discount if tickets are purchased before Aug. 1. Standing tickets can now be purchased for \$27.50 with reserved seating tickets at \$32.50.

After Aug. 1, those prices increase by \$5 respectively.

Advance ticket purchase for Laura Story will not be needed. Tickets will be sold at the ticket booth on the fairgrounds. Tickets are \$5 each or a family ticket of four or more for \$20.
